In such event the successful bidder will deposit the additional performance security to the extent of the differential cost of bid amount and 90% of the estimated cost in shape of POSB/NSC/POTD/KVP deposit receipt of schedule bank duly

- pledged in favor of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Center, and Bhubaneswar at the time of signing agreement.
- 2 The tenderer are requested to go through the conditions of tender and on fulfillment of the conditions, they may apply for tender paper. Non eligible contractors may participate in the tender at their own risk.
 - 3 The original document shall be verified by the tender committee, if required after opening of the tender.
 - 4 The Engineer contractors (Degree or Diploma holder) desirous to avail the facility of exemption of EMD is required to submit an affidavit to the effect that he/she has not yet participated as such in 3 (three) works during the current financial year.(2009-10)& produce the original license at the time of opening for necessary entry without which the tender will be considered "Non responsive". TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The rate of all materials are including cost, transportation, royalties and other taxes and levies .
2. The tenderer are requested to go through the conditions of tender and on fulfillment of the conditions, they may apply for tender paper.
3. Bidders having experience in relevant works only will be eligible for the work and his experience certificate of such work which is to be obtained from the appropriate authority , under whom such work has been executed successfully will only be the tender taken into considered.
4. The work order will be issued to the successful tenderer only on execution of agreement in F₂ form of P.W.D, Govt. of Orissa.
5. The attested copies of up to date certificate of Pan card & VAT clearance certificate (as per VAT rule-612) should be enclosed along with the filled in tender documents
6. The bidder must have completed a relevant work value of which is not less than the 60% of the tender value within last three years . For this purpose , his work value will be calculated up dating 10% of every year.
7. The work will be completed within **30 days (one month)** from the date of issue of the work order and extension of time for completion of the work will not be allowed under any circumstances.
8. The Income Tax and Sales Tax as applicable from time to time shall be deducted from the bill.
9. The authority may put an end to the agreement at his discretion any time in case of supplying of sub- standard materials. The authority may remark or reject the same and have it replaced, deducting the value of removed/ rejected materials from the amount due to the party as per actual.
10. Security deposit @5% of the bill amount will be deducted from each bill & this amount will be refunded after six months of completion of work in case no deficiencies/discrepancies are detected.
11. The D.T.C.N will form the part of agreement, when the tender is accepted.
12. The tenderer should sign in all pages of the tender document including the pages containing technical specifications and the conditions of the tender schedule. All corrections / alterations should duly be signed by the tenderer.
13. The successful tenderer should start the work in the premises of this center as per prevailing rules & restrictions of the center.
14. The authority reserves the right to reject incomplete tenders or tenders received after due date and time.
15. Tender papers should be sent by registered/ speed post & can also accepted for dropping in the Tender Box. It is the responsibility of the tenderer to see that the papers reach within the scheduled time. Delay in transit will not be the responsibility of the authority. The cost of registration fees to and for will be borne by the intending tenderer.
16. E.M.D. (1% of estimated cost) in shape of POSB/NSC/POTD/KVP/Deposit receipt of schedule bank duly pledged in favor of undersigned shall be furnished along with tender. The earnest money will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderers on application and same will be retained in case of successful tenderers and will not carry any interest
17. The structural design/ drawing and specifications enclosed along with the tender documents should be strictly adhered to and no deviation on these shall be accepted.

- 18 .Royalty of the building materials shall be deducted as per bill quantity at the admissible rate, if the tenderer have not submitted any authentic receipt/ K-form issued by the local Thasildar.
19. Additional performances security shall be deposited by the successful bidder when bid amount is seriously unbalanced i.e. less than the estimated cost by more than 10%, in such event the successful bidder will deposit the additional performances security to extent of differential cost of bid amount and 90% of the estimated cost in shape of postal offices bank account/N.S.C/ K.V.P/ B.D of any schedule bank duly pledged in favor of the undersigned at the time of signing of agreement.
- 20 The contractor shall not employ any person below the age of eighteen.
- 21 Tenderer are not required to write their name on the outer cover containing the tender documents. They are only required to write the name of the work and authority who had issued the tenders.
- 22 Any dispute arising out of execution of the work if not settled mutually can be referred to and will be settled by appropriate court within the jurisdiction of Bhubaneswar for judicial scrutiny and not arbitration.
23. Only ACC / Konark / Ultratech / Lafarge cement will allowed for use in all Concrete works.
- 24 The authority reserves the right to reject any or all tenders or a part thereof without assigning any reason thereof.

DETAILED TENDER CALL NOTICE

(FOR BUILDING/ ROAD WORKS)

1. Sealed tenders on prescribed form to be eventually drawn up in P.W.D. form No. F-2 will be received up to **2.00 P.M. on 2nd Feb 2012** by the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar for the construction of work:- **“Tender schedule for construction of walking path in fragrant corner garden at RPRC, Bhubaneswar”** from C/ D class contractors and will be opened by the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized agents at **3.30 PM on 2nd Feb 2012**. The amount of the estimate is approximately **Rs.4,84,000/-** (Rupees four lakhs eighty four thousand only). In case of all lump-sum contracts and item-rate contracts exceeding Rs. 20.00 lakhs each tenderer who intend to furnish "Special conditions" if any, should furnish their tenders in two separate sealed envelopes Le. one containing "Special conditions" (super-scribed on the cover as technical bid and conditions) & the other "Rates for different items of work" in the prescribed schedule supplied by the Department being super-scribed on the cover as 'Rate bid'. The envelope containing "Special conditions" will be opened first in the presence of tenderers or their authorized agents and will be evaluated after obtaining clarification if any, from the concerned tenderers. In case any of the "Special conditions" is not acceptable to the tender accepting authority, wholly or partly, the sealed envelopes containing "Rate" of the concerned tenderers will not be opened. All sealed envelopes containing "Rates" will be closed in a separate cover and sealed by the officer opening tenders in the presence of tenderers or their authorized agents. After evaluation of the special conditions the date, time & place for opening the sealed envelopes containing the "Rates" will be notified to the tenderers. The sealed envelopes will be opened in the presence of tenderers or their authorized agents. The "Rates" quoted by each tenderer will be read/out in additions to the amount evaluated for each tender on account of "Special conditions" attached to the respective tenders.

2. The tenderers should please note that the work will have to be completed within one calendar months commencing from the date of issue of work order. Tenderers are required to submit detail programme of work along with the tenders, which they consider necessary keeping in view of the clause-2 of the P.W.D. Form-F-2. Without these programmes of works, the tender will be considered defective. Authority for acceptance of tenders would rest over the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar.

3. Earnest Money Deposit:

Tenderers are required to pay Earnest Money for **Rs.4,900/-** either in shape of National Savings Certificate / Kissan Vikash Patra / Postal Office Time Deposit Account / Post Office Savings Pass Book, Deposits Receipt of Schedule Bank duly pledged in favour of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar otherwise their tenders will not be considered. The earnest money will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderers on application and the same will be retained in case of successful tenderers and will not carry any interest.

4. (a) The Plan and Specification for the work can be seen at the Office of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar during working hours and days. Complaints at a future date that the plan and specifications have not been seen cannot be entertained. The contractor may obtain a set of tender documents for the work from the Office of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar on payment of

Rs. 4,000/-+ 4% Vat (Rupees two thousand and VAT rupees eighty) (non-refundable) for the tender paper in cash or through remittance by postal money orders. It should, however, be noted that the RPRC will not be responsible if there is any delay in receipt of tender documents by the intending contractor through speed post/ registered post. Their offers will not be considered on any account even if tender documents were dispatched by the tenders before the due date. The cost of registration fees to and for will be borne by the intending tenderer.

4. (b) All other information can be obtained on application to the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar.

5. The Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar reserves the right to reject any or all tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.

6. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) & Initial Security Deposit (ISD):

The tenderers whose tender is selected for acceptance shall within a period of seven days upon written intimation being given to him of acceptance of his tender make an initial security deposit 01 % (one Percent) of the tendered amount as shown in clause (3) above so that the earnest money and initial security deposit will be 2% of the tendered amount and sign the agreement in the P.W.D. form F-2 (schedule XLV No. 61) for the fulfillment of the contract in the Office of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar. The security deposit, together with the earnest money and the amount withheld according to the provisions of F-2 agreement shall be retained as security deposit for the due fulfillment of this contract. Failure to enter into the required agreement and to make the security deposit as above shall entail forfeiture of the Earnest Money. No tender shall be finally accepted until the required amount of security deposit (money) is deposited. The written agreement to be entered into between the contractor and the RPRC shall be the foundation of the right of both the parties and the contract shall deem to be incomplete until the agreement has first been signed by the contractor and then by the proper officer authorized to enter into the contract on behalf of the RPRC. The Department will accept the security deposit in form of National Savings Certificate / Kissan Vikash Patra / Postal Office Time Deposit Account / Post Office Savings Pass Book, Deposits Receipt of Schedule Bank duly pledged in favor of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar and in no other form.

7. Rate in Words & Figures:

The rates should be quoted in words and figures and the Units in words otherwise the tender will be liable for rejection. In case of discrepancy between words and figures, the words shall prevail and in case of discrepancy between Unit rates and totals, the Unit rates shall prevail. The rates should be quoted in Rupees and paisa but not in Rupees and annas. The tender shall be written legibly and free from erasures, overwriting or conversions of figures. Corrections where unavoidable, should be made by scoring out, initialing, dating and rewriting. The tenderer should also show the total of each page and grand total of whole tenders.

8. The contractors will be responsible for payment of all royalties or other charges for quarrying materials. All local taxes inclusive of State VAT and Income Tax. Octroi charges, Ferry and Tollage charges are to be paid by the contractor.

9. PAN CARD & VAT Clearance Certificate:

The tender may not, at the discretion of the competent authority be considered unless accompanied by Certificate of Registration, Income Tax Clearance Certificate /PAN Card, VAT Clearance Certificate (VAT-612) / Labour License (Xerox copy of each duly attested) along with the tender documents & the original certificate are to be produced before the Executive Engineer at the time of opening of the tender.

10. If the contractor removes any materials or stock so supplied to him from the site of work with a view to disposing off the same dishonestly, he should in addition to any other liabilities Civil or Criminal arising out of the contract he liable to pay a penalty equivalent to five times the price of the materials on stock according to the stipulated rates and the penalty so imposed shall be recovered from any sum that may then or at any time thereafter become due to the contractor or from his security.

11. The contractor should be fully liable to, indemnify the RPRC for payment of any compensation under Workmen's Compensation Act-VIII of 1923 on account of the workmen being employed by him and the full amount of compensation paid will be recovered from the contractor.

12. Every tenderer must examine the detailed specification for Orissa before submitting his tender. The right is reserved without impairing the contract to make such increase or decrease in the quantities or items of work mentioned in the schedule attached to the tender notice as may be considered necessary to complete the work fully and satisfactorily. Such increase shall in no case invalidate the contract or rates. It shall be definitely understood that the Govt. does not accept any responsibility for the correctness or completeness of the quantities shown in the schedule. The schedule is liable to alteration by omission or additions or deductions and such omissions deductions shall in no case invalidate the contract and no extra monetary compensation will be entertained.

13. No departmental materials will be supplied to the contractor.

14. The contractor will have to bear the cost of straightening, jointing, cutting, welding etc. of all steel reinforcement and structural and no cut pieces less than 1 (one) metre length will be accepted. After completion of the work the contractor has to return all surplus and good materials at the issuing store at his own cost failing which the cost of the unutilized balance departmental materials and such other damaged materials not acceptable to the Department would be recovered from him at 5 times the stock issue rates.

15. Deleted:

16. All reinforced cement concrete work should conform to Orissa Detailed Specification and should be of grade M-150/200 with 12 mm. to 20 mm. size black hard crusher broken granite stone chips (20mm. size not to exceed 25%) having a minimum compressive strength (in work test) 150 kg/200 kg/Cm² ub 15 cm. cubes at 28 days after mixing & tests conducted in accordance with IS 456 and IS 516.

17. Shuttering and centering shall be with seasoned Sal wood planks the inside of which shall be lined with suitable sheeting and made leak-proof and water-tight or alternatively steel shuttering and centering may be used.

18. The contractor shall make all arrangements for proper storage of materials at his own risk. But in cost for raising shed for the storage of materials and pay. of watchman etc. will not be borne by the RPRC. These are all to be borne by the contractor. The RPRC is not responsible for considering the theft of materials at site. It is at contractor's risk. Under any such plea if the contractor stops the work, he shall have to pay the penalty as per clauses of the F-2 contract.

19. For the purpose of jurisdiction in the event of dispute if any contract should be deemed to have entered into within the rate of Orissa and it is agreed that, neither party to the contract nor the agreement will be competent to bring a suit in regard to the matters covered by the contract at any place outside the State of Orissa.

20. After the work is finished, all surplus materials and debris are to be removed by the contractor and preliminary work such as vats, mixing platforms, etc. are to be dismantled and all the materials are to be removed from the site. No extra payment will be made to contractor on this account. The rate quoted should be inclusive of all these items, ground upto 15 metre shall be cleared and rough dressed.

21. The contractor shall not interfere with the execution of water supply of electrical fitting arrangements and any other works entrusted to any other agency by the RPRC at any time during the progress of the work.

22. The RPRC will have the right to inspect the scaffolding and centering made the work and can reflect partly of fully such structures if found defective in their opinion.

23. The contractor will have to arrange for water supply for all works and made sanitary arrangements at his own cost for his labour camps, the contractor has to arrange adequate lighting arrangements for night works whenever necessary at his own cost.

24. Bailing out water from the foundation either rain water or sub-soil water is if necessary should be borne by the contractor. No payment will be made for bench marks, level pillars profiles and benching and leveling ground where required. The rates quoted should be finished items of work inclusive of these incidental items of work.

25. All the quantities mentioned in the schedule are combined for ground floor and multi-floors incase of Multi-storied building and the rates should be through for the same.

26. Cement concrete in roof slabs, beams and wherever prescribed by the Engineer-in-charge shall be machine mixed and vibrated, and the contractor should arrange his own concrete mixers, vibrators, pumps etc. for the purpose.

27. It should be understood clearly that no claims whatsoever will be entertained.

28. The tenderer shall have to abide by the C.P.W. safety Code introduced by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Works.

29. The contractor will abide by the fair wages clause as introduced by the Government.

30. The RPRC will have the right to supply at any time in the interest of work any Deptt. materials to be used in the work in addition to those mentioned in the clause No. 13 and the contractor shall use such materials without any controversy or dispute on that account. The rates of such materials will be at the stock issue rates fixed by the Department plus storage charges or market rates which ever is higher.

31. The contractor will be responsible for the loss or damage if any, of departmental material, equipments supplied to him under clause 13 and 30 during execution of the work due to reasons whatsoever and the cost of such materials will be recovered from him at the prevailing stock issue rates plus storage charges or market rates whichever is higher.

32. Contractor's T & P

The contractor should arrange at his own cost necessary tools and plants such as Pulms, Vibrator, concrete Mixer etc. required for the efficient execution of the work and rates quoted should be inclusive of the running charges of such plants and cost of consumables.

33. The Contractor will have to submit to the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar monthly return of labour both skilled & unskilled employed by him on the work.

34. The tenderers are required to go through each clause of P.W.D. Form F-2 carefully in addition to clause mentioned herewith before tendering.

35. No part of the contract shall be sublet without written permission of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar or transfer be made by power of attorney

authorizing others to receive payment on the contractor's behalf.

36. No tender documents will be sold to the intending tenderers after the last date stipulated for selling of Tender papers.

37. If any further necessary information is required, Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar will furnish such but it must be clearly understood that tender must be received in order and according to the instructions.

38. Cement shall be used by Bags and weight of one cubic meter of cement being taken as 14.42 quintal.

39. In the event of any delay in the supply of Department materials or supply of details structural designs for unavoidable reasons, reasonable extension of time will be granted of the application of the Contractor. But no claim for monetary compensation will be entertained under any circumstances.

40. No contractors will be permitted to furnish their tender in their own manuscript paper.

Sample Materials:

41. Every tenderer is expected before quoting his rates to inspect the site of proposed work. He should also inspect the quarries and satisfy himself about the quality, availability of material "medical aids, labour and food stuffs, etc. and the rates may be inclusive of all these items of work. In every case the materials must comply with the relevant specification and sample of materials in sealed bag may be submitted along with the tender for approval of the Chief Executive, Regional Plant Resource Centre, Bhubaneswar.
